

“modulyss GECA-certified carpet tiles, distributed in Australia by Gibbon Group, with econyl yarn and bitumen backing can be recycled at the end of their life cycle.

Gibbon Group (by mutual agreement with modulyss), has a product stewardship program in place and guarantee that the modulyss carpet tile reclaimed under this program will NOT GO TO LANDFILL.

modulyss carpet tile to be recycled must meet the following requirements:

1. Free of all types of debris and uncontaminated by any toxic substances, such as solvents (adhesive residue on the backing is acceptable)
2. No other carpet tile backing other than modulyss Back2Back - such as PVC or other carpet backings - would be acceptable.

Procedure would be as follows:

- In those instances where the carpet tile is in relatively good condition, the tiles would be cleaned and either made available for re-use or for collection for shipment to modulyss for recycling.
- All carpet tiles would be palletized and in clean condition for re-use or recycling.
- The modulyss take back program will be offered on a project by project basis.
- Transport costs from the site to Gibbon Group in Queensland and onto the manufacturer in Belgium) are calculated on a project specific basis.
